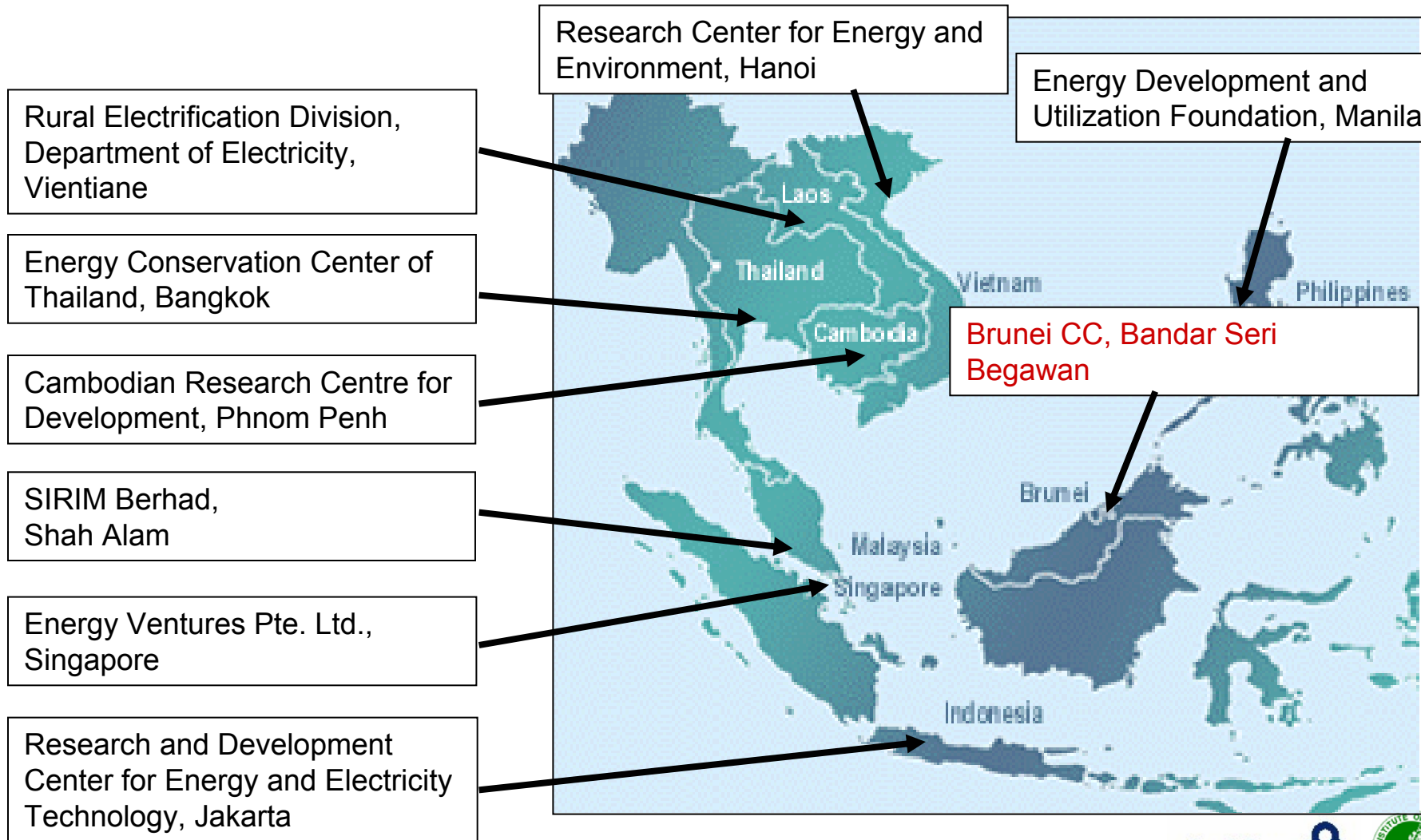

Activities:

Full Scale Demonstration Projects (FSDPs)

Objective:

Demonstrate the technical reliability and economic viability of proven European cogeneration technology to ASEAN end-users

- 24 FSDP Candidates selected
- Capacity: 0.3 – 41 MW (Total: 174 MW)
- Total Amount of EC support: 8.6 mill. EURO
- Total Investment: 209 mill. EURO
- 10 projects are expected to be implemented by end of 2004
